

# It's a done deal!

Revelations of Forgiveness: It's a done deal!

**Ps 32:1-2** Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, Whose sin is covered. Blessed is the man to whom the LORD does not impute iniquity, And in whose spirit there is no deceit.

*Here's a sneak preview of New Testament truth: forgiveness, the removal of all sin, & the imputation of righteousness. The Holy Spirit gave this inspiration to the writer of this Psalm, to alert the Hebrew people, & all others that would read this truth, that redemption would manifest, bringing liberty, release, & transformation, through the work of salvation! What a wondrous concept: that the Lord would not account sin against His people, & that they could be crystal-clear & spotless! That concept is now & forever a truth, through the redemption that Jesus manifested!*

**Ps 85:2** You have forgiven the iniquity of Your people; You have covered all their sin.

*It's a done deal, revealed here many centuries ahead of Calvary, that God would make provision for the cleansing, removal, putting away, & carrying away of sin from mankind! The prophet reminds us here that not only is some of our sin cleansed, all of it is! That means that every transgression, past, present, & future, has been dealt with by the mercy & salvation of the Lord! Sin has been put away forever more!*

**Ps 130:3, 4** If You, LORD, should mark iniquities, O Lord, who could stand? But there is forgiveness with You, That You may be feared.

*It's always been the nature of God to forgive transgression & to release people from guilt! From immediately after Adam & Eve's fall from grace in the Garden of Eden, until the death of Jesus at Calvary, God promised the cleansing from sin for all of man, & gave periodic references to it through the declarations & writings of His prophets! God is the Lord of forgiveness, He always has been, & forever will be! Jesus secured our forgiveness, & the Holy Spirit imparts that forgiveness into us in the New-birth!*

**Dan 9:9** To the Lord our God belong mercy and forgiveness, though we have rebelled against Him.

*What a revelation for the people of God to get into their hearts: in the midst of & in spite of the rebellion of mankind, God has provided unlimited mercy & forgiveness through the redemption that Jesus legally wrought, & that the Holy Spirit vitally manifests in us! Before Adam rebelled in Eden, God had already determined to manifest redemption in the fullness of times! Nothing takes God by surprise, so we can trust in Him for everything we need, at all times, just as He has provided eternal forgiveness!*

**Acts 5:31** Him God has exalted to His right hand to be Prince and Savior, to give repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins.

*Jesus IS the forgiveness of God! He is the gift of forgiveness & redemption! He came to be the Prince of Peace, Savior of all of mankind, to redeem Israel & the world-at-large, & to effect the cleansing from sin that God required. Jesus became the Lamb of God that carried off the sin of the world, & once He did, it became a 'done deal'! Repentance is a change of mind or direction: when we look to Jesus for forgiveness, cleansing, healing, restoration, that's the action of repentance! Repentance isn't some good & holy work of self-righteousness that we do, it's us looking to Jesus & His finished work of Calvary & the redemption that He provided! Again, just as Jesus provided forgiveness for us, His redemption provided our cleansing from sin. So repentance isn't any works we do, it's an action we take in our heart as we look to, call upon, & trust in the salvation through Jesus that we've received! Remember that repentance isn't something YOU do, it's leaning on & trusting in what Jesus did for you! **Hebrews 12/2** tells us to look unto Jesus, who is the author & completer of our faith!*

**Acts 13:38-39** Therefore let it be known to you, brethren, that through this Man is preached to you the forgiveness of sins; and by Him everyone who believes is justified from all things from which you could not be justified by the law of Moses.

*Because of all that Jesus accomplished in redeeming us, forgiveness from God, & total cleansing from the sins of the past, present, & future have been dealt with & provided once & for all, (all of time & all of mankind)! Not only did the Heavenly Father provide forgiveness through Jesus, but He also manifested the fullness of justification for mankind, not holding their sin against them, & placing them into right standing with Himself! (2 Cor. 5/19). Another important divine-truth is mentioned in the passage above: nothing we could do on our own could earn the righteousness of God for ourselves, not even trying to fulfill all of the commandments of God. So justification & righteousness had to be provided by God Himself, along with the forgiveness & cleansing from all sin that was necessary in order for salvation to be imparted all of time! So, again, I remind you that forgiveness, cleansing from sin, & release from all guilt before God is a privilege that we possess, by the grace & love of God!*

**Acts 26:18** to open their eyes, in order to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who are sanctified by faith in Me.’

*Jesus accomplished all of this through His death, burial, resurrection, & ascension into Heaven, & the Holy Spirit imparts all of these truths as manifested realities in us at our New-birth! So deliverance from spiritual darkness has come forth, as has our freedom from the power of Satan, an inheritance as children of light, & full sanctification as heirs of God & co-heirs of Jesus! The total & eternal cleansing from sin before God was part & parcel of the package of salvation that we’ve received!*

**Eph 1:7** In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace

**Col 1:13-14** He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.

*I listed these two vital passages together because they echo the same truth. We have been blessed with full redemption, victory over the works of darkness, freedom from condemnation & a sense of guilt before God, & right-standing in the Holy Trinity. We are complete in the Lord, & all that He is we have become by grace.*

**Col 2:13** And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses,

*We are dead to sin through what Jesus did for us, we’re alive in His righteousness, & we are partakers of His divine nature. Sin has been dealt with, purged, cleansed, removed, carried off, done away with, & put away forever, by the Lamb of God, Jesus, who carried away the sin of the world! We are the righteousness of God in Christ, & His righteousness has no unholiness, darkness or fault! We’re forgiven in full, once & for all, because we’re without spot, wrinkle, or blemish in union with God through Jesus Christ!*

**1 John 2:12** I write to you, little children, Because your sins are forgiven you for His name’s sake.

*All that we have, all that we are, is because of (Jesus) Christ in us, our hope of glory. His sacrifice put away our sinfulness, brought justification & glorification for all of time!*

  
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
