The Good News of Salvation

John 3:15 so that whosoever believes in Him should not perish, but have everlasting life.

Anyone receiving Jesus as Savior & source of salvation receives everlasting life (the life of God, the resurrection life of Jesus, by the Holy Spirit)! If you receive the eternal life of God, you lose the nature of sin, & because God is eternal, His life is eternal, you become possessed with eternal life! Whereas everyone was born spiritually separated from God, everyone calling upon Jesus becomes one with God, forever! Once you receive eternal life, your nature is changed from within, you become a partaker of the divine nature, & that nature is eternal!

Previous to receiving salvation, you were an eternal being that had not the life of God in you, so you would've been separated from God eternally if you'd died in that condition, but since you called upon Jesus, you are spiritually united to God forever more! That's good news!

John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only-begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

God hasn't hated the world, He doesn't hate the world, nor will He hate the world. He did love, does love, & will love the people of the world, that's why He created the world to begin with! The sin that He hates has already been dealt with by Him at Calvary. The sin of the history of fallen mankind was placed upon Jesus once & for all, & the sin of the world was carried away from before God & from between Him & mankind! God rescued the world from spiritual death by sending Jesus, & anyone calling upon Jesus activates that rescue, which is for eternity! The Gospel Truth is that if you become one in spiritual life with Jesus, you can't spiritually perish! That's God's will for you, me, & everyone in life that will respond to His calling of them! If you're Heaven bound, you can't end up in Hell!

God is love, He has love, He gives love & all you have to do to receive it is believe it, by calling upon Jesus for the gift of eternal life, for whomever calls upon Him receives His life! That's good news!

John 3:17 For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but so that the world might be saved through Him.

God has no desire to send anyone to Hell, His commitment is to draw them to Himself & give them eternal life with Him, forevermore! Because of Adam's transgression, everyone was born with a sinful nature, separated from God, & spiritually dead. God brought forth Jesus to deal with the fall of humanity & to provide total redemption & restoration between Him & them! God has no condemnation in His redemptive plan, only the people rejecting the gift of eternal life are sealed into condemnation, by sending themselves to Hell. God doesn't appoint anyone to Hell, He calls us all towards Heaven, but the choice is ours to make, similar to the choice Adam & Eve made in the Garden of Eden when they ate of the fruit God told them not to eat. God warned them that in the day they would eat of the fruit of the forbidden tree they would spiritually die! They made the choice, God didn't entice them to reject His Word, Satan did, & they responded. Jesus also responded to the will & Word of God, in our behalf, & we are now one with God! That's good news!

John 3:18 He who believes on Him is not condemned, but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only-begotten Son of God.

If you're Born-again, you are not condemned to Hell! The Bible tells us that whoever calls upon the (name of the) Lord shall be saved! It says that they that believe in Him shall not be put to shame! There's no greater shame than being cut off from God forevermore, & that can't happen once you're born again, because you're born of incorruptible seed, by the Word of God which lives & abides forever!

Only people going into eternity without eternal life by Jesus are condemned into Hell forever, & God didn't send them there, they sent themselves by rejecting the door of eternal life, which is through Jesus!
